

Instructions for the Mentor/Adviser Assessor

To the Applicant: Write your name on the form. Ask three mentor/adviser assessors to accomplish the form. These must be professors, organization moderators/advisers (in school or in the community), or school administrators who are witness to your leadership performance. Please allow the assessors sufficient time to complete the form. Ask the assessors to submit this form in a sealed and signed (across the flap) long letter envelope directly to the school officer in-charge of nominating applicants from your school. Unsealed, unsigned or tampered envelopes will not be considered.

To the Mentor/Adviser Assessor:

Thank you for being a/an Mentor/Adviser Assessor for _____, who is applying to the **2nd Angat Kayumanggi Youth Camp (AKYC 2011)**, which will be held on 20-23 December 2011.

The Angat Kayumanggi Youth Camp (AKYC) is a summit for 30 of the most outstanding student leaders selected from High Schools all over Region VII during which they will hone their leadership passion, skills, and potential.

5. Personal qualities and characteristics that impact on his leadership.

Enclose the completed form in a long letter envelope with the name of the applicant written in the front of the envelope. Seal the envelope, sign it across the flap and submit it directly to the school official in-charge of nominating applicants from your school. Do not give the envelope to the applicant.
